All the cheeses are handmade, using traditional methods and use cow's milk from either their own farm or from a nearby dairy.

Tiresford Cheshire Golden Brie. Made using milk from Tiresford's award winning pedigree herd of Guernsey cows. It has a distinct yellow colour, caused by the unique ability of the Guernsey cow to convert beta carotene (now recognised as a powerful anti-oxidant) from the sunshine, through the grass into the milk. No other breed of cattle can do this. It won the Best Soft Cheese Award at the 2009 Food Northwest Awards in Manchester, as well as successfully beating both the French and Somerset Brie at the Bath and West Agricultural Show. **Available as a whole cheese, approx. 150g, our price is £3 for members and £3.50 for non-members.**

Mrs Bourne's Mature Cheshire. The Bourne family has been hand-making fine Cheshire cheese since 1930. They still use traditional 'hands on' techniques to produce cheeses which have been awarded gold, silver and bronze medals at the British Cheese Awards, prizes at the Nantwich International Cheese Show and Gold and Silver Medals at the World Cheese Awards. **Available as a 200g wedge, delivered vacuum packed, priced at £2.75 for members and £3.25 for non-members.**

Burt's Blue. Burt's Blue cheese began its life in January 2009. Through the care and attention of cheesemaker Claire Burt, Burt's blue became a Gold award winner in the 2010 Nantwich Cheese Awards. Burt's Blue Cheese is a semi-soft blue made in Altrincham Cheshire, with quality milk sourced from a local dairy, for a richer flavour. It is made in a small vat making each cheese a labour of love. **Available as a whole cheese, approx. 200g, our price is £3.50 for members and £4 for non-members.**
